Owning Opportunity: 60 second summary

- Energy Efficiency currently isn't delivering to its full extent on reducing emissions, increasing energy security and lowering bills, due to lack of progress in owner occupied homes.
- Introducing regulations for minimum energy efficiency standards for sale of homes, coupled with green financing options for households, would meet the above and generate a stable, self sustaining industry.
- We propose introducing a requirement on basic, low cost measures with green finance funding to be in place for households by 2026.
- A further round of more advanced measures should be introduced in 2029 if this initial regulation is successful.
- This approach breaks the boom and bust cycle to energy efficiency, and would rapidly scale up growth in a sustainable way.
